



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Day 2 Wed Mar 1 Arrival Israel / Jaffa

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport. Meet your local guide and driver for the next 10 days of your Journey of the Land of Bible. On the way to your hotel by the Mediterranean stop for a visit of Jaffa (Joppa) where Peter stayed with Simon the Tanner. (Acts 9:43, 10:9-23) Overnight in the Coastal Plain area

Day 3 Thu Mar 2 Coastal Plain / Galilee

Drive along the Mediterranean Coast to Caesarea the site where Paul defended himself before Festus and King_Agrippa (Acts 25:6-26:32). Tour the Aqueduct and the restored Roman Amphitheater. Visit the new Museum and see the movie that will take you on a magical journey through Caesarea's history. Drive through the Jezreel Valley to Mt. Carmel and Muchraka where Elijah challenged and defeated the 400 prophets of Baal. Continue to Megiddo the fortress city of King Solomon and where the final Battle of Armageddon will take place. (Revelation 16:12-16).

Overnight by the Sea of Galileer

Day 4 Fri Mar 3 The Galilee

Travel to **Nazareth and Cana** for views of the childhood home of Jesus. **Continue through Jezreel Valley** to the **Spring of Gideon** where Gideon selected the 300 men who would join him in fighting against the Midianites (Judges 7:1-7). Visit **Beth She'an** and tour the excavations that have revealed **Israel's** largest ruins of a Roman City. Stop at **Yardenit** to have a **baptismal** service for those wishing to be baptized as Jesus was in the **Jordan River**. (Matthew 3:13-17).

Overnight by the Sea of Galilee

Day 5 Sat Mar 4 Sea of Galilee - Golan Heights

Visit the **Boat Museum** to see the 2000 year old "Jesus Boat" which was discovered in 1986 and sail across the **Sea of Galilee**. Tour **Capernaum** where Jesus chose to center his ministry. Continue to the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). Stop at the cursed cities of **Korazin** and **Bethsaida**. Drive up the **Golan Heights** to **Banias** site of ancient **Caesarea Philippi** where Peter confessed Jesus as the Christ.

Overnight by the Sea of Galilee

Day 6 Sun Mar 5 Jordan Valley - Dead Sea

Travel through the **Jordan Valley** to **Kaser El Yehud** where Joshua crossed over the **Jordan River** with the Children of Israel and where John the Baptist baptized people. From there drive to the **Dead Sea** the lowest area in the world. Hike to **Ein Gedi** to see the desert oasis where David hid from King Saul. (I Samuel 23:29). Visit **Massada** the fortress built by King Herod. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the excavations including the ancient synagogue, Herod's palace, water cisterns and bathhouses. Take a **dip** in the therapeutic, salt mineral water of the **Dead Sea**.

Overnight in the Dead Sea area

Day 7 Mon Mar 6 Dead Sea - Jerusalem

Start the day at **Qumran** the site of the discovery of the **Dead Sea Scrolls**. Travel up to **Jerusalem** via the Judean Wilderness. Stop at **Abraham's Tent** and ride a camel at **Genesis Land**. Enter the **Holy City** as a pilgrim and enjoy the first glimpse of the **City of Jerusalem** from **Mt. Scopus**. **Drive** to the **Mt. of Olives** for a panoramic view of the Old City of **Jerusalem**. This is where Jesus began His **Palm Sunday** journey into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1-9). Walk down the **Palm Sunday Path** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the night in prayer (Matthew 26:36-46). Then tour the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas** at St. **Peter in Gallicantu** where Jesus was tried by the Sanhedrin and imprisoned for a night (Matthew 26:57-75). Visit the **Upper Room** where Jesus had His final Passover with His disciples (Luke 22:7-38). **Overnight in Jerusalem**

Day 8 Tue Mar 7 Jerusalem

Tour the City of David (the Hazakiah's Tunnels and Pool of Siloam). Enter the Old City through the Zion Gate and walk through the resorted Jewish Quarter and the Western ("Wailing") Wall. View the Dome of the Rock and Al Aqsa Mosque on top of the Temple Mount. Visit the Davidson Centre hi-tech imaging presentation of the ancient temple, then the archeological excavations around the Western Wall and south west side of the temple. Visit the Pool of Bethesada (John 5) Saint Anne's Church with its wonderful acoustics. Walk through the Via Dolorosa to visit the Church of the Sepulcher. Sound and Light at the David Citadel walls this evening.

Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 9 Wed Mar 8 Jerusalem

Spend some time at Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Memorial, visiting the memorial sites and the New Museum. Drive to Government Hill to see the Knesset Israel's Parliament and the Menorah, symbolizing the state of Israel. Visit the Israel Museum to see the

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Travel documents

Travel documents and tickets, will be provided when ready, approximately two weeks prior to departure.

Passports / visas

A valid passport for at least six months after returning home is required by all Canadian and USA citizens. A visa is a stamp in your passport that permits you to enter a country. It is the passenger's responsibility to verify and obtain a visa if needed according to citizenship. Presently a Visa for Israel is not required for Canadian & USA citizens. If you are not a Canadian or USA passport holder, please check the Israeli consulate in your country for visa requirements. Also, check what visa requirements are necessary to enter back into Canada. If you hold a permanent resident card, bring it with you.

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These may differ from those found in your country of Origin. The standards and conditions there with respect to the provision of utilities, services and accommodation may also differ from those found in your country of origin. This tour requires that you be in good physical and mental health, able and willing to actively participate. Check with your doctor for the most up to date information regarding personal **health recommendations** for your comfort level. Take a sufficient supply of any medications you are taking, copies of your prescriptions and the telephone or fax number of your doctor. If you wear glasses bring an extra pair.
